I. INTRODUCTION

The purpose of this document is to set out the criteria that will be used by CIOC and CIASA to select pool Swimmers for the Commonwealth Games 2026.

II. SWIMMER ELIGIBILITY

- Team members must sign the 2025-26 RTC agreement. Team members who are not in good standing may be dismissed at any time at the discretion of the RTC and/or the CIASA Technical director.
- 2. The selection criteria for the 2026 CAC Games Selection:
 - A) Only swimmers with Caymanian by right or status will be eligible.
 - C) The final number of swimmers selected will be based on available funding as determined by the CIOC. The final selection will be determined by CIASA and the CIOC working together.
 - D) Selection recommendations will be based on 600 World Aquatics Points and forwarded to the CIOC for their final selection.
 - E) Each swimmer's two highest-scoring events will be used for selection based on Sept 01, 2025 to may 31, 2026.
 - F) Each athlete must agree to the "meet preparation agreement" at the time of selection.

- G) Selected or pre-selected Cayman resident swimmers may be asked to attend regular "2026 CAC Games Team" training/practice sessions and are expected to attend.
- H) All swimmers selected for the team are expected to comply with the expectation to rest and perform to their best for the 2026 CAC Games.
